Deuteronomy 6⁴ “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord *is* one! ⁵ You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. ⁶ “And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ⁸ You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Re-Display Deuteronomy 6

The Shema – Deuteronomy 6:4

⁴ “Hear, O Israel: Specific The Lord our God, Yahweh Elohenu the Lord Yahweh *is* one! echad cf. Genesis 2:24
v. 4 YHWH (Yahweh) alone is your God.

Re-Display Deuteronomy 6:5

⁵ You shall love The verb אָהַב (*'ahav*, “to love”) in this setting communicates not so much an emotional idea as one of covenant commitment. To love the Lord is to be absolutely loyal and obedient to him in every respect, a truth Jesus himself taught (cf. John 14:15).¹ First

the Lord your God with all your heart, In OT the heart (לֵב, לֵבָב; *levav, lev*) was considered the seat of the mind or intellect, so that one could think with one’s heart.² Thoughts

with all your soul, *Heb* “soul”; “being.” Contrary to Hellenistic ideas of a soul that is discrete and separate from the body and spirit, OT anthropology equated the “soul” (נֶפֶשׁ, *nefesh*) with the person himself. It is therefore best in most cases to translate נֶפֶשׁ (*nefesh*) as “being” or the like.³ Identity

and with all your strength. The strength (*mě’ōd*) is, of course, the physical side with all its functions and capacities.⁴ Actions

v. 5 Make sure YHWH comes first in everything: your thoughts, your identity, and your actions.

⁶“And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.

⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. Passover blood on doorposts gates were “city hall” symbolizing the whole house and dictating family decisions. Mezuzah 23 framed quotes or prayers Picture Pam's Mezuzah 2 Cor. 5:7

vv. 8-9 Make sure YHWH's Word determines values, actions, and decisions for your family.
