Several years ago our Christian & Missionary Alliance denominational leadership began to encourage churches to provide sabbaticals for ordained pastors.

In 2009 our Board of Ministries adopted a Staff Handbook for employees of DAC. Included in the same was a provision to make a three month sabbatical available to our pastoral staff upon completion of seven years of ministry, and every seven years thereafter. A pastoral sabbatical is not vacation and has four main purposes: Recuperation, Refreshment, Research, and Relaunch. Currently, after 15 years of pastoral service, Pastor Mike Duffy is on a 3 month sabbatical concluding August 11. Like Pastor Juan Sali in 2017, Pastor Mike submitted to me an intentional research proposal (which includes extensive travel), and will review those results with me upon conclusion. But, it is more than research. It is also recuperation and refreshment in preparation for a fresh relaunching of ministry. In appreciation to Christ for Pastor Mike, join me in praying our Lord will do all these and more for Mike in the coming weeks.
